The DIGITAL Fellowship 2024

The DIGITAL (Digital Rights and Inclusive Technology for All) Fellowship 2024 is an exciting fellowship opportunity to work on digital and non-digital rights. The Fellows will be placed with a civil society organisation/litigation chambers to expose them to litigation, and work with the Centre for Communication Governance, NLU Delhi to develop legal and policy research.

Applicants must:

- Be born on or after January 1, 1989;
- Be registered with the Bar Council of India, or have a provisional registration with a State Bar Council;*
- Demonstrate a strong interest in and commitment to the development of digital rights; and
- Have excellent legal writing, drafting and oral advocacy skills.

* Applicants with a provisional registration with a State Bar Council may be eligible to apply if their registration is valid until 31 May 2025.

The Fellowship will commence in **April 2024**. A monthly, non-negotiable stipend of INR 50,000 will be provided to each full-time Fellow.
